The Dialogue

An animated film about Aron Forsius who lived in the 1600s.

The short film is made for a *Kinetoscope*, the forerunner of the motion-picture film projector, invented by *Thomas A. Edison* and *William Dickson* in 1891.

Forsius is one of the most famous early natural philosophers from Finland (then part of Sweden). Around 1611 he compiled the first Swedish-language manual in natural science under the title Physica. It's a translation and processing of *Johannes Magirus* Physiologia. Physica was published 400 years after Forsius death.
